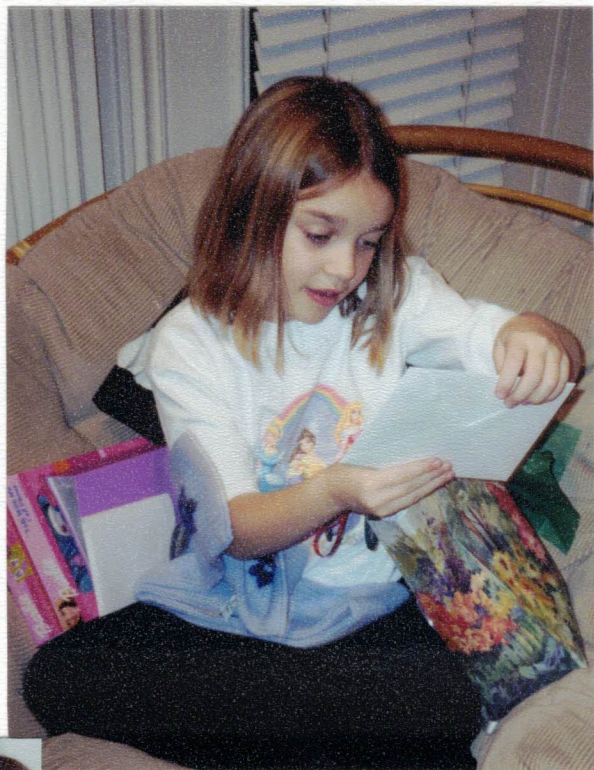

Electrical fire closes Mountain View early

THE DAILY HERALD

Mountain View High School students were let out of school early Friday after an electricity transformer on the west side of the building caught fire.

At about 9 a.m., the insulation on the wiring and about 500 gallons of mineral oil inside the transformer started on fire, said Reed Rieske, acting battalion chief with the Orem Fire Department. The transformer, located on the outside of the building, burned for about an hour.

While there were no injuries, the Orem high school and 35 other Utah Power and Light customers lost power, including the Orem Recreation Center located just east of the high school and Orem Elementary School. Power was restored to everyone but the high

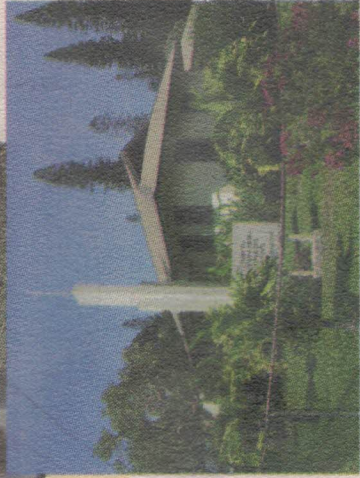
"In my talk [at the dedication], I challenged Lanai Branch members to use that monument as a focal point to remind themselves of those sacrifices and to view themselves as modern-day pioneers. I told them that a pioneer is someone who goes ahead to prepare the way for others. Those 45 active members are pioneers in their own way, and they are there to prepare the way for others."

President Aguilar told the *Church News*: "The members of the Lanai Branch as well as of our stake have a great appreciation of what this monument stands for. The monument brings to light the sacrifice and obedience of early pioneers who obeyed the call of establishing 'Iosepa,' a gathering place for the saints of the Hawaiian islands. It celebrates the legacy of dedicated Hawaiian saints who committed their lives to our Savior.

"A knowledge of their great struggles, hopes and accomplishments helps us recognize how the hand of God is continually touching and blessing this land, and gives modern pioneer saints faith to continue the job and duty of expanding the kingdom of God."

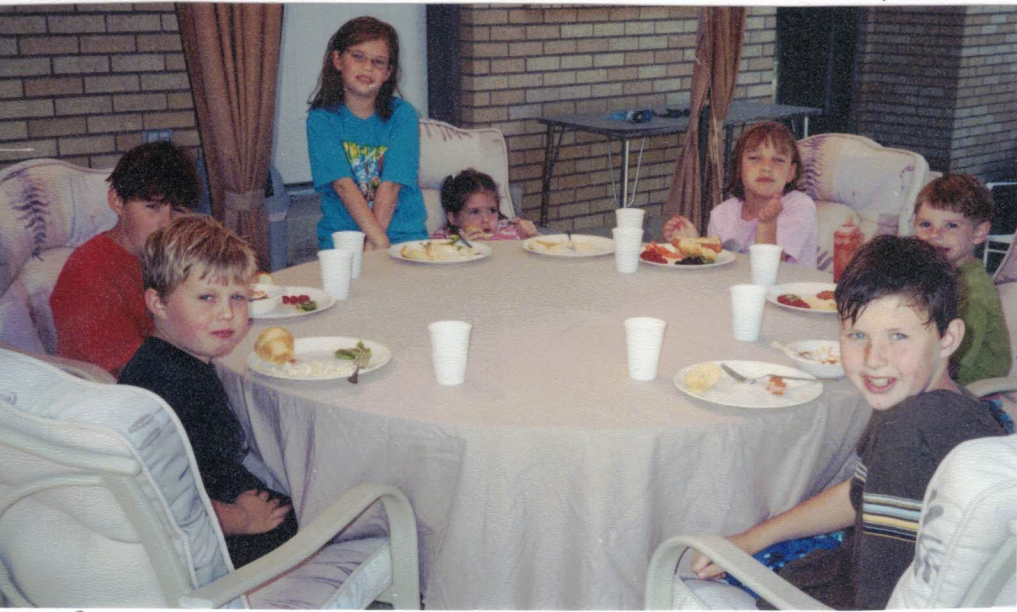
In his address, Brother Wilson reminded the gathering that the Lana'i experience was similar to trials the Mormon pioneers faced in Missouri and on Zion's Camp, and noted that Lanai was a training ground for these faithful Hawaiian saints. He bore a testimony of Doctrine and Covenants 58:2-7, emphasizing the words from verse 4 that "after much tribulation come the blessings."

OREM — Last Wednesday, Stephanie Tanner-Brown said she heard a sliding glass door open downstairs. She assumed it was one of her older children returning from school until her 3-year-old son came bounding up the stairs and said, "It's the quiet man. He's going through your things."

Then, Tanner-Brown heard the glass door close again and realized someone had been in her home. She contacted Orem police.

Tuesday morning the man returned, and this time he wasn't so quiet, Tanner-Brown said.

About 10:30 a.m., Tanner-Brown was home with her 3-year-old when she saw something moving out of the corner of her eye. She thought it was her son until she called out his name. That's when she saw the intruder, who reached into a bag, pulled out a gun and pointed it at her.

"I said 'no, no, no' and I ran to the door," Tanner-Brown said during a press conference with the media Tuesday night. "Then I realized, I

Sandy last week, and Orem police Lt. Doug Edwards said both incidents had the same "M.O."

"He was the same guy," said Sandy Police Sgt. Marty Hooker.

The man entered the home through her daughter's downstairs bedroom, said Stephanie Tanner-Brown, who was home alone with her son at the time of the incident. The man pointed a gun at her and bound Tanner-Brown to her son after she refused to let him go.

"I said 'Don't hurt my boy,'" said Tanner-Brown, whose son had marks on his legs and arms from being restrained. "He said 'I don't want to hurt him. I just want cash.'"

The man asked for cash and for opiate-based drugs, Tanner-Brown said. The man stole financial cards and told Tanner-Brown he would hurt her if she didn't give the PIN to him. He also told her if the number was wrong he would come back and kill her, she said.

The man eventually left in the family's minivan and stole an undisclosed amount of cash using one of the financial cards, police said.

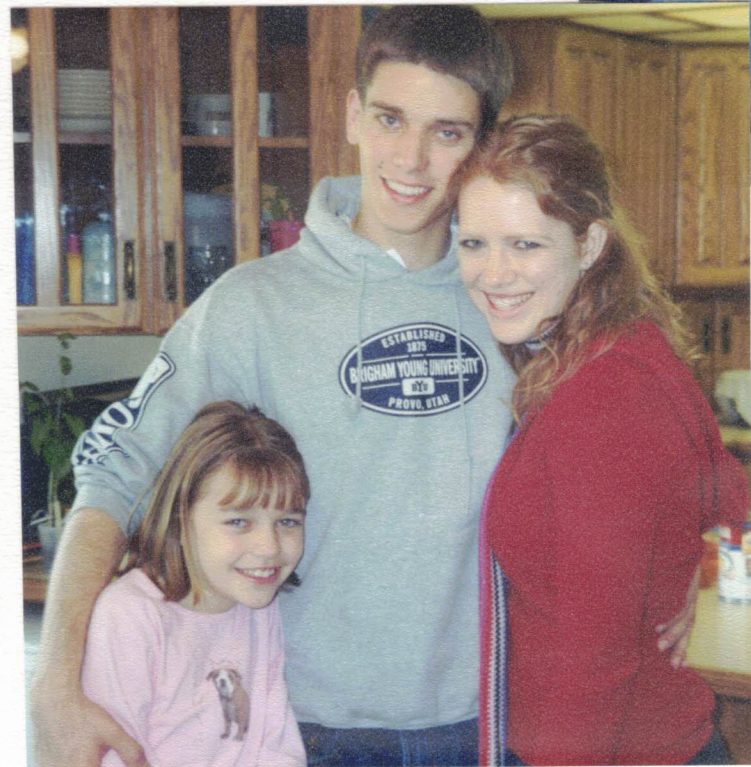
