### Instructions

- You may use your notes, the internet, help menus, etc. (i.e. the exam is "open book"). You may use ChatGPT or another LLM.
- You may not look at another persons exam or ask them for help, but you may of course ask clarifying questions to Dr. Tree or the TA.
- You may not ask someone on the internet for help (including forums like Stack Exchange or sites like Chegg).
- You need a computer to complete this exam. You may use either the lab computer or your own computer.
- You may use scratch paper, but it will not be accepted for credit.

  - You must submit a **single** Excel file and a **single** Python file.

  - **Do not use Jupyter** for this exam.
